As mentioned above, over the past five years \$3 million in grants have been received to improve the once blighted area along US Route 40 (Harding Highway). This effort was multipronged involving the eventual acquisition of eleven properties in Richland through grants, economic development dollars, and two bond issues. One bond issue was for \$400,000 in 2003 and the other was \$450,000 in 2004 which are payable over ten years at 4.25% interest, The bonds were publicly advertised and voted on unanimously by the Township Committee. The bonds purchased the Richland Post Office, the deli (King's), the feed mill, the green barn next to the feed mill, the old gas station at Main Avenue and Route 40 along with Saw Mill Park. Also purchased were the Patcong building, the house that became Shiloh's Crafts and the old white farmhouse. The income from the Richland Post Office (\$19,000 per year) and King's Deli (\$6,000 per year) help to meet the obligation to repay the bond debt.
