# DAMAGE DESCRIPTION AND DIMENSIONS:

During the incident period of December 19 - 20, 2009, a record snowfall disrupted transportation and public safety systems.

Roads were closed or severely compromised creating threats to public health and safety, limiting access to medical facilities, schools, food, fuel, utilities and access for police, fire and rescue units. A major disater was declared on February 5, 2010. For this Project Worksheet accumulated debris from heavy rainfall and snowmelt damaged the drainage system, (inlets, pipes and storm manholes) and roads on several roadways around West Beach Avenue, (for details see attached quotation from A&B Grading).

### SCUPE OF WORK:

### Fund at 75%

To repair the facility to its pre-disaster condition the City of Buena Vista Township solicited three (3) bids per their procurement policy to perform permanent repair and received only one (1) reply for a Pre-CEF cost of \$258,770.

The subgrantee is requesting direct administrative costs that are directly chargeable to this specific project. Associated elegible work is related to administration of the PA project only and in accordance with 44 CFR 13.22. These costs are treated consistently and uniformly as direct costs in all federal awards and others subgrantee activities and are not included in any approved indirect cost rates.

Note: The City of Buena Vista Township used their Standard Procurement Procedure for bid with only (1) bidder responded, (see attached copy from the applicant).

Maintenance records from the Buena Vista Township Drain Cleaning Program were verified and demostrated good maintenance for all drains and lines in the area. (see attached documentation).
