DAMAGE DESCRIPTION AND DIMENSIONS:						
DURING THE INCIDENT PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 5 - 7, 2010, A RECORD SNOWFALL DISRUPTED TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY SYSTEMS. ROADS WERE CLOSED OR SEVERLY COMPROMISED CREATING THREATS TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY; LIMITING ACCESS TO MEDICAL FACILITIES, SCHOOLS, FOOD, FUEL, UTILITIES AND ACCESS FOR POLICE, FIRE AND RESCUE UNITS. A MAJOR DISASTER WAS DECLARED ON MARCH 23, 2010. Approximately 2 ft. of snow covered the township of Buena Vista causing dangerous and hazardous conditions throughout the entire area.						
SCOPE OF WORK:						
Fund at 75%						
Harsh weather conditions during the snow event caused the roads of Buena Vista Township to become very frail and unstable. While their Department of Public Works laborers were out plowing snow off of the streets a couple of roads were damaged. In the process of the plow truck pushing snow to the side of the roads it was also scraping up pieces of the frail roads which caused various cracks and holes to appear in the streets. A total of 4 roads (Beach Ave., Rome Rd., Lake Ann rd. & Clover St.) are being claimed for damage repairs for this project worksheet. Three roads Beach Ave., Rome Rd. & Lake Ann Rd., only have road damage. One of the roads, Clove St., has road damage as well as damage to a corrugated pipe in that area as well. Due to excessive flow of melted ice, snow and vegetation flowing into the pipe, the pipe became clogged and damaged and the street that it travels under has cracked. The applicant will contract out the work to rip up the street to repair it and lay out a new pipe. The applicant received quotes for the total cost of repair for each road from Benjamin Construction and the lowest were used to compose the CEF in this PW (See proposals attached). This is large project and a CEF was done for this PW.

-Caused by harsh weather conditions

-Current pipe needs to be removed and replaced with the same type of pipe (36"x42" corrugated pipe) and the cracked roadway needs to be compacted and reshaped.

-Total quote cost for repairs: \$31,665.00
